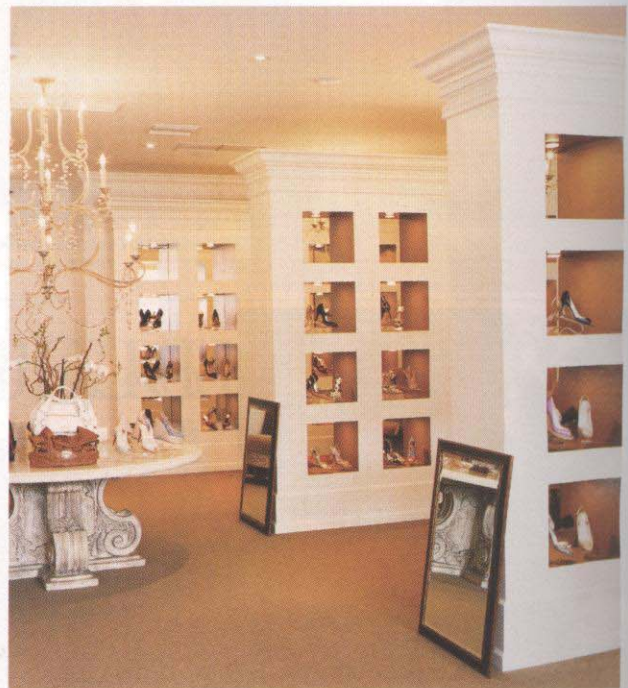
New stores, incredible finds, secret sources
